



U18 AA HEAD COACH

The Moose Jaw Minor Hockey Association (MJMHA) is accepting applications for the position of the **U18 AA Head Coach** for the 2023-24 season.

MJMHA is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person to work with a group of young athletes to foster good sportsmanship, work ethic, and healthy competition. The candidate should have demonstrated coaching experience, knowledge of the U18 age group needs and requirements, demonstrated hockey knowledge, and ability to travel with the team when required.

The U18 AA Head Coach must have, or be able to achieve the following certifications:

- Development 1 or High Performance 1 Certification
- Respect in Sport
- Checking Certification
- Goalie Coach Certification (or Assistant Coach must have)
- A current Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC)
- A valid driver's licence

The roles and responsibilities of the job include:

- Work with the MJMHA Board of Directors/Tier Director and Development Director on an as needed basis to maintain development programs for U18 aged players;
- Attend the U18 Fall Evaluations and continue to evaluate players through an exhibition series;
- Prepare and deliver a season plan including off ice requirements, practice plans and game line ups;
- Select qualified assistant coaches, team manager, and other team personnel as needed;
- Attend the U18 AA scheduling meeting in the fall to plan the MJMHA U18 AA season;
- Attend the MJMHA Coach's Meetings as required;
- Develop an ongoing program that provides a consistent experience for players and parents; and
- Liaison with other AA coaches in the Association to develop long term program development.
